The Site: The Orana Girl Guides Camp is situated at 146 Roches Beach Road, Roches Beach, Tasmania. It is approximately 20km to the east of Hobart and around ten minutes' drive from Hobart Airport. The site has excellent facilities including a main hall and kitchen, accommodation, playground, beach access and camp grounds are available for the more adventurous.

Accommodation: The site has two accommodation blocks with an average of 4 - 8 bunks per room for a total of 84 bunks. Please bring your own sleeping bag; pillow case and toiletries, there are en suite toilets in each block, as well as an additional two toilet / shower blocks outside near the main camp area. Under the GSG agreement priority for the bunk rooms will be given to wayfarers, provided they book before the 17th August 2014. After that date, the bunk rooms will be open to all on a first in, best dressed basis. Past experience has shown us that the cabins go very quickly so book early if you are wayfaring. Otherwise for those who are interested there are plenty of camping sites!

The Cost: Please book by Friday 19th of September (After this date a \$20 surcharge will apply.) The cost includes accommodation and all meals. There is an additional \$5 charge for Non-Members.
